ILLINOIS

A series of wins and successes in Springfield for immigrant communities!

- \$38M for immigrant services line
- \$105M for Welcoming Centers
- Earned Income Credit expansions will cover 1 million new residents, including ITIN filers
- HB 4343 Medicaid coverage for 42+ regardless of status (see here)
- Right to Counsel in Immigration Proceedings Act (SB 3144)

FEDERAL

Our workgroup created a CIMH sign on letter for the DHS Public Charge comment period ending 4/25. Stay tuned for a listsery e-mail this week.

- On April 1st, Biden Administration announced plans to end Title 42, but upholds MPP
- Time article comments on the Administration's contradictory immigration policy actions
- April 15 Biden announced <u>TPS</u> designation for Cameroon

Policies we are tracking



Title 42

- Title 42 expulsion order effective May 23
- 21 states join lawsuit against **Biden Administration**



Federal Budget

- \$81 Billion in DHS funding
- Homeland Security budget proposed \$97.3 Billion
- ICE funding includes requirement to publish data on those in their custody



DACA

- USCIS opens online renewals
- No updates on January public comment period



Immigration Enforcement

Memo to OLPA advising dismissal of nonpriority cases (See <u>Borderlines summary</u>)

- · Highest priority to threats to national security; lowest priority to "border security" (recent border crossers)
- Instructs attorneys not to file Notice to Appear, preventing the filing of nonpriority cases



Asylum

EOIR/DHS/USCIS release interim rule based on public comments from Oct 2021 NPRM

- Transfers decision making to USCIS officials (See Human Rights First)
- Public comment closes May 31
