Action Alerts



ILLINOIS

- <u>HB4437</u> is pending with house human services appropriations committee; has support from Latino, Black, Progressive & Asian Caucuses
- NAMI-Chicago <u>advocacy efforts</u> for FY23 funding for the Mental Health Early Action on Campus Act
- Latino Policy Forum advocates for more funding for IL Welcoming Centers to support mental health

FEDERAL

- Public Charge rule posted to federal registrar on Feb 24. Our workgroup is preparing a CIMH sign-on letter for public comment deadline Apr 25
- Final <u>letter</u> in support of Violence Against Women Act of 2022 signed by 740 local, state, territorial, national, international & tribal organizations
- <u>Expand protections</u> for Afghan SIV holders, halt deportations, and provide international aid for humanitarian response

Policies we are tracking

TPS

- March 3 DHS announced 18month <u>TPS designation for</u> <u>Ukraine</u>; <u>ICE halts deportations</u> to Ukraine, Russia, & 7 other European countries
- March 16 DHS announced 18month <u>TPS designation for</u> <u>Afghanistan</u>
- Federal Spending Bill
 - <u>\$26 billion</u> to ICE, CBP, Alternative to Detention programs
 - <u>\$212 million</u> for children and youth mental health resources
 - <u>\$13.6 billion</u> in Ukrainian aid

Title 42

- March 12 Biden Administration <u>upholds</u>
 <u>exclusion for UAMs</u> (in response to
 March 4 <u>TX ruling</u>)
- March 4 <u>Federal appeals court</u> barred expulsions of families with children to any country where they could be harmed


